

## **CA Report to Dorsey's Search Village 2/12/2020**

- The Board approved the FY2021-22 budgets. Changes from the draft budgets included adding \$100K for Downtown Columbia Partnership by reducing IT funding by \$85K, Inner Arbor funding by \$5K and community centers repairs and maintenance by \$10K. \$85K will be included in the 2022 budget for upgrades to the Locust Park and Jeffers Hill neighborhood centers. Funds for renovation of the Stone House and Art Center in Long Reach have been on hold pending a resolution of the village center redevelopment and will now be released.
- An assessment will be made of putting an ADA bathroom on the 2<sup>nd</sup> floor of the Oakland Mills Other Barn. The proposed elevator for Oakland Manor has been removed from consideration.
- A questionnaire is being sent to Village Managers regarding accounting practices.
- There is no further news on a new spa tenant at the Haven. Negotiations continue.
- Construction of Symphony Woods pathways will begin shortly. The pathway routes are currently staked out with project completion expected by spring 2020.
- Tomorrow's CA Board meeting will include:
  - a presentation on Howard Hughes Corporation's vision for Merriweather District and, possibly, the Lakefront Core and North Lakefront areas
  - an update on additional swim lanes for the Clippers
  - a Hyla Brook easement request to reduce flooding
  - discussion of the most recent Development Tracker
  - Capital Projects and Open Space updates
  - applicable State Legislation
  - discussion on Next Steps regarding the Neighborhood Centers
