

## **Report to Dorsey's Search Village Board – March 9, 2022**

- The FY23 Budget was approved. No last-minute changes were made.
- There has been no progress in releasing the Symphony of Lights agreements to the public. I am continuing to work to open this up in the interest of transparency.
- A subcommittee will be presenting possible amendments to the Minority Business Enterprise policy that has been extended through April 30, 2032.
- The sidewalk in front of the Dorsey swimming pool is being repaired.
- The County is offering a walk-through of its proposed Plum Branch stream restoration project that will be running on the streambed beside and behind Dunloggin MS. Event is scheduled for 4-5pm Thursday 3/24 and will meet on the gravel pathway across the street from the school.
- HHC has found a new tenant for the Clyde's Restaurant and Sundry space. CA is negotiating with them to allow use of CA lakefront land for outdoor seating as was the case in the past.
- HB1060 (HOA Bill of Rights) is no longer on the CA lobbyist's hitlist but is now being "monitored." I'm not sure what exactly that means.
