

## **Report to Dorsey's Search Village Board – April 21, 2022**

- After months of secrecy, the Symphony of Lights legal agreements were suddenly released without explanation.
- A subcommittee presented possible amendments to the Minority Business Enterprise policy that has been extended through April 30, 2032. Questions were raised as to how granular minority business categories should be. I am concerned that there are no accountability requirements – all is aspirational.
- The Board is considering Emergency Cash Reserve Funding, Advisory Committee Structuring and a revised Ethics Policy.
- It was agreed to provide \$120K in funding to Inner Arbor Trust upon receipt of past years audited financials.
- Residents have expressed concerns about past and future stream restoration projects. Key issues are failure to address stormwater source management and unnecessary tree removal. I am trying to get a staff response.
- HHC has found a new tenant for the Clyde's Restaurant and Sundry space. CA signed a lease last December allowing use of CA lakefront land for outdoor seating as was the case in the past. Details of the lease were revealed after a resident threatened a FOI suit.
- CA Board elections are being held in Wilde Lake, Harpers Choice and Hickory Ridge. All incumbents are "Rouse Project" connected. Urge your friends to vote.
